After acquiring the mix of a general store and a grocery store in 2018 from the Larry White estate, Mears has a bright vision for her trading post.

"It's been a lot of smiles, a lot of customers saying, we're so happy you're finally open again!" Mears said. "I wanted to be that convenience for people in the town."

Going forward, expect a full-service deli with made-to-order breakfast sandwiches, gas pumps and a creemee machine to be functioning by the summer and, potentially down the line, a pizza oven.

"It has been quite the learning experience," Mears said. "It's crazy and it's hectic but I'm really enjoying it."

Grace Wilson recognized as SVC employee of the month

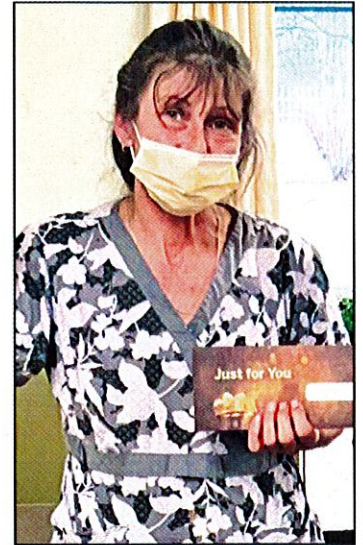
