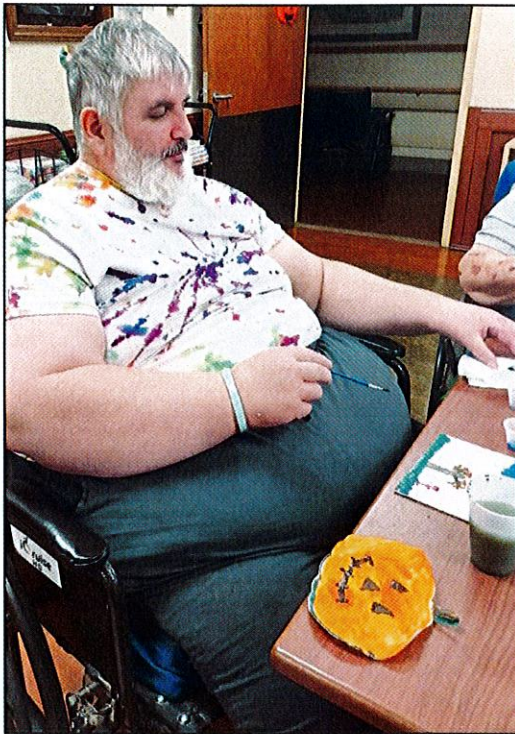


Artistic talent applauded at Granville Center
